Alongside this, you will assist with a range of estate maintenance tasks, like fencing and maintenance of structures. You will also be driving our tractors and making use of our tractor driving area, as well as on the farm. You will also learn how to plant crops, sow seeds, propagate plants and manage orchards.

As a Level 1 course, this diploma is all about introducing you to the Land Based industry and developing your essential skills. You'll be learning from experienced professionals, who are there to give you the very best start to your career.


