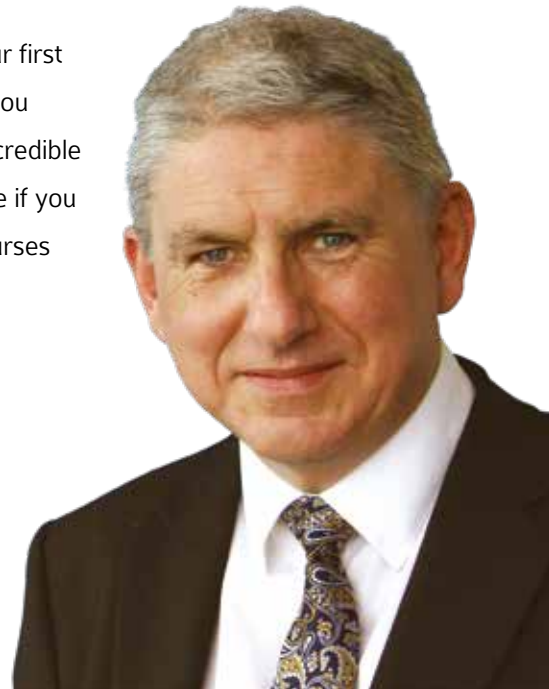

When you finish your GCSEs, your options are...

Do I have to pay for my course?

After GCSEs you are able to access three-years of full-time study free of charge. Apprenticeships can be started at any age (if you are 19+, this still won't cost you, but your employer will have to contribute to apprenticeship fees).



START YOUR CAREER NOW WITH AN APPRENTICESHIP



If you know the career route you want to follow, why wait? You can start your career now with an apprenticeship programme, where you can:

- Earn a real salary
- Learn skills in the workplace
- Train with a workplace mentor and our experienced team of college tutors
- Get qualified and improve your future earning potential!

We have a recruitment team to help you get started. Our advisors will help you with applications, CV writing and provide you with interview guidance to help you stand out from the crowd.

Throughout your apprenticeship you will have the support of your college tutor to ensure your learning is on track and an apprenticeship advisor who will visit you at work and make sure you are happy and thriving in the workplace.

Apprenticeships can also take you higher, with a range of new Higher Apprenticeships now available, you may be able to continue your apprenticeship on to degree-level. Many apprenticeship programmes also offer UCAS tariff points giving you the chance to go on to university if you want to later in life. Apprenticeships can also lead on to further professional qualifications that could advance your career.

If you are applying for an apprenticeship you need an employer who is willing to take you on as an apprentice. If you don't have an employer please speak to the recruitment team.

PREPARE FOR YOUR CAREER WITH A QUALIFICATION AND REAL WORK EXPERIENCE



Our full-time study programmes offer qualifications, work experience and work competencies, which give you a great start to your career.

We believe that the purpose of education is to prepare you for a successful working life, which goes beyond qualifications. At the career college we want to give you the edge you'll need for your chosen career.

We will help you gain industry relevant skills through work experience, build your confidence and life skills through our work competencies programme and give you specialist subject knowledge and qualifications through your time with us.

Work experience

All of our courses have a work experience element and this is where you will gain insight into possible future careers and immerse yourself in real work; on your CV this will show future employers you are work ready. Some programmes also offer 350 hours of industry placement.

Work competencies

We prepare you for the workplace by helping you develop work ready skills which include punctuality, reliability, meeting deadlines, communication, resilience, problem solving, innovation, financial acumen, planning, prioritising and much more.

Specialist knowledge

We have strong partnerships with employers who help shape the curriculum, to make sure your training is relevant, giving you an edge when you start your chosen career.

Skills to business

It is a requirement for all 16-18 funded Study Programme learners to undertake a Work Experience Placement with a relevant local employer for a minimum of one week.

Work Experience and Industry Placements offer an exciting opportunity to enhance your skills and knowledge. You will understand first-hand the sector you're interested in, get ready to work and open up a world of employment opportunities after college.

Inclusive work experience

At The Cornwall College Group, we offer inclusive work experience in different areas across our campuses. We're proud to help students who aren't quite ready to enter the world of work develop their behaviours and industry-specific skills.

All inclusive placements have job descriptions with bronze, silver and gold tasks to work towards. At all stages, our work experience team review the placement to see whether a student is ready to progress. Whether this be to a group external placement, supported by the college, working with local employers, or to the end goal of an independent work placement.



COURSE LEVELS AND ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

It is important to choose the correct level of course after your GCSEs. Making the right choice will depend on meeting the entry requirements, how you like to study and what you would like to do after.

Please use the table below as a general guide to our entry requirements. Acceptance on a course will also depend on a successful interview.

Please note

- *For any applicants considering undertaking an apprenticeship, you will need an employer willing to take you on as an apprentice, which is a process that we can support you in. With regards to entry requirements, please note that prior to starting an apprenticeship you will need to complete an initial assessment in English and maths, so that we can establish the level you are currently working at. We will then run through a Skills Scan with you, in order to determine your current level of knowledge and skills in your chosen area of study. Both of these elements will then be used to determine the level of apprenticeship which is most suitable for you to start at, irrespective of grades awarded in previous qualifications.
- Some specialist courses may have extra entry requirements, please see website for details.
- If you do not achieve your expected grades please do not panic. Contact us and we will help you find an alternative course, normally in the same subject area of interest.

GCSE GRADES

GCSE GRADES UPDATE

In 2017 the grading system for GCSE English and maths changed significantly. Rather than being graded A* to G, a numerical system is now used. The grades now run from 1 to 9, with 9 being the highest. A grade 4 is now a ‘standard pass’, equivalent to a grade C, with a grade 5 being a ‘strong pass’.

GCSE ENGLISH AND MATHS

According to the Department for Education, gaining a grade 4 or higher in English and maths could potentially add £2,000 to your salary every year. If you have not yet gained a grade 4 in GCSE English and maths then you will carry on studying these subjects as part of your Study Programme at college. Our English and maths teams are committed to helping you succeed, and we offer a different and more personalised experience than school.

Our GCSE courses run from September until June, giving you the chance to gain your qualification in just one academic year.

Not quite ready for GCSEs yet? Don’t worry, we have a range of ‘stepping stone’ qualifications in English and maths meaning that you can improve your skills at your own pace. If you have already gained your GCSE English and maths at grade 4, we will continue to embed English and maths into your specialist course, as these skills are essential for your future employment.

When you join us, we will assess your current levels of English and maths, and use your existing qualifications to make sure that you are on the right course for you.

HOW TO JOIN US

We make it as easy as possible to apply to study with us. Our team of advisors will talk you through your options and recommend the right programme and level to start at. You will then get the chance to meet the course tutor in an informal interview to talk in-depth about your application and aspirations. Here is our simple guide to applications. 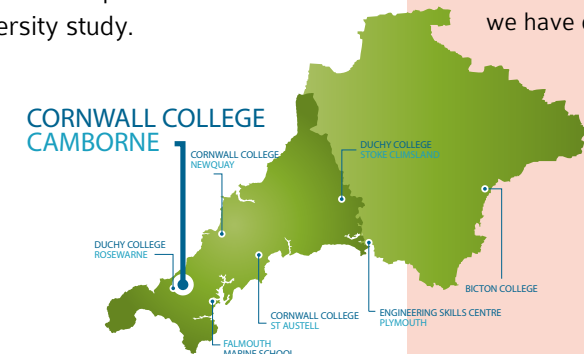


Transport

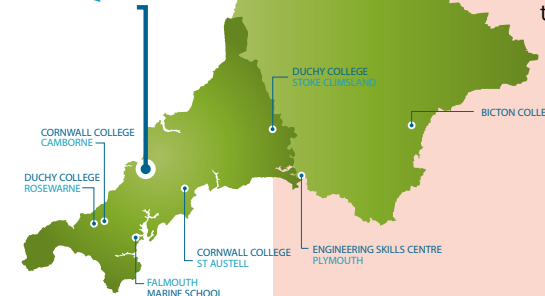
Transport

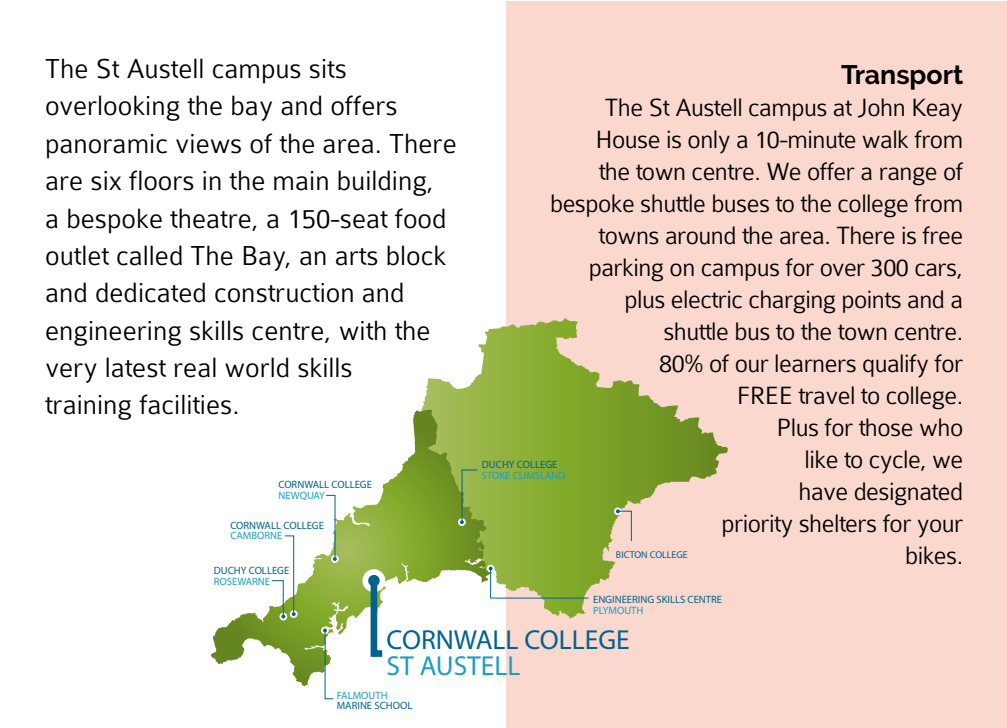
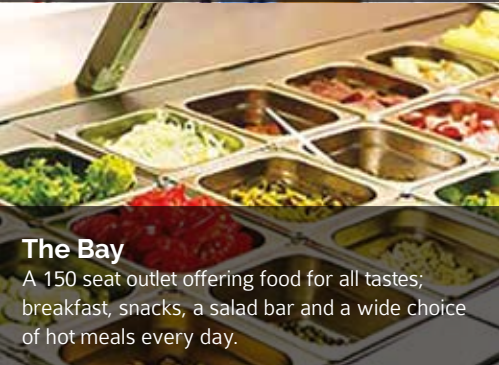
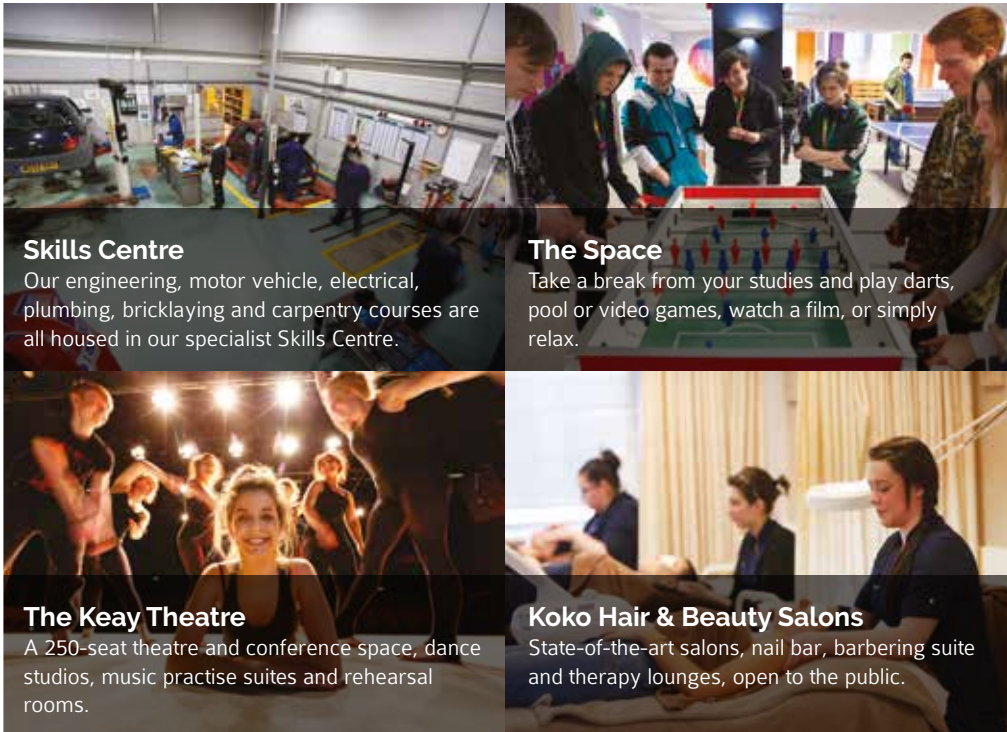

Future Farm

Cornwall now boasts a major research and innovation dairy farm, Future Farm. Located at Duchy College Stoke Climsland, Future Farm is helping improve the efficiency, welfare and technological advancement in dairy farming. It's a huge benefit for the next generation of workers and leaders in the sector. Learners from across all of our land-based campuses will have access to state-of-the-art equipment, data and research tools to widen their knowledge, skills and behaviours. Future Farm is home to 220 cows that can be grouped into three mini-herds to research the latest innovations in dairy.

Exciting partnership to transform care training in Cornwall

Cornwall Care and The Cornwall College Group (TCCG) have partnered to create a new Care Academy that will secure the quality training and development of the county's next generation of carers. Care Academy at Cornwall College St Austell will ensure you receive the best quality education and training in a dedicated area with the equipment and resources you will need in your career. Cornwall College St Austell boasts an entire section of its campus for the Care Academy, providing training rooms, interactive bed caring stations as well as larger meeting areas. The two-year, Level 3 Health and Social Care Practice course is an exciting new way to develop the skills and competencies needed for a career in the health services and/or social care field.

Falmouth Marine School Boatbuilding training buoyant after 100 years

October 2020 marked 100 years of Falmouth Marine School providing training for the boatbuilding industry, an integral part of the maritime history of Cornwall. On the 1st October 1920, 96 apprentices from Cox & Co (Falmouth Docks) began their boatbuilding apprenticeships with the college and since then we have continued to provide students with first-class experience within the industry, which is proving to lead directly to employment with companies such as Princess Yachts Limited, Gweek Classic Boatyard, Fibrefusion Limited, Cockwells, Rustler Yachts and more.

Ecology apprenticeships are breaking new ground

THE UK's first ecological post-graduate degree apprenticeship course is being pioneered in Cornwall.

The course, set up by The Cornwall College Group (TCCG) in partnership with the Eden Project, will allow participants to secure a master's degree in ecological restoration and specialise in one of three ecological subjects while working full-time.

Dr Mark Nason, head of Eden Project learning, said: "This is a UK first and an incredible opportunity for businesses as well as students."

The course has been designed in direct response to the demand seen

in such a hands-on industry – students can earn whilst they learn and employers will help create experts in the field whilst being seen to have a strong commitment to this vital sector."

Businesses interested in taking on an apprentice ecologist are being urged to attend a virtual event to find out how their firm could benefit – including how those that recruit before September will receive the £3,000 government bonus.

The "blended" nature of the level-seven ecologist apprenticeship being delivered by TCCG will involve weekly virtual lessons and four five-day residentials at the Eden Project over two years.

The course was created by 10 employers to combine expertise

in such a hands-on industry – students can earn whilst they learn and employers will help create experts in the field whilst being seen to have a strong commitment to this vital sector."

Dr Nason said: "A recent report from a committee of MPs said that a severe shortage of trained ecologists is hampering efforts by local governments to oversee biodiversity policies, with the committee recommending investment in training and skills as part of the Government's plans for green jobs. We're incredibly proud as a college to be positioning ourselves at the forefront of environmental education with a huge variety of courses covering biodiversity, conservation, ecology and sustainable agriculture."

AGRICULTURE

Agriculture makes a significant contribution to the economy in the South West of England and provides a wide range of exciting job opportunities. Our courses provide all of the skills and knowledge required for a successful step into the sector, regardless of whether or not you are from an agricultural background. We are the region's largest land-based education and training provider with our campuses located in the countryside.

Study Full-time

LAND-BASED STUDIES (AGRICULTURE) DIPLOMA LEVEL 1

Where: Bicton College and Duchy College Stoke Climsland
Entry Requirements: Two or more GCSEs at grade 2 or above, or successful completion of Entry Level qualification.

This one-year course is an ideal introduction into the land-based agricultural industry, where you will gain the hands-on practical skills, experience and knowledge of a variety of farming disciplines, designed to prepare you for employment. These include: safe working, farm animal husbandry, crop husbandry, tractor operation, fencing, and other estate skills.

Progression: Agriculture Technical Certificate Level 2 or Agriculture (Stockperson) Apprenticeship Level 2.

AGRICULTURE TECHNICAL CERTIFICATE LEVEL 2

Where: Bicton College and Duchy College Stoke Climsland
Entry Requirements: Three or more GCSEs at grade 3 or above, or successful completion of a relevant Level 1 qualification.

This one-year course covers general mixed agriculture including crops, livestock, tractors and machinery. You will be introduced to the fundamentals of plant, soil and animal science and how these influence the growth, yields and quality of our crops and livestock. You will examine how crops grow, how to plant them, how to look after them and how to harvest and store them. You will learn about the health, welfare, nutrition and reproduction of farm livestock and learn the basics of business management and farm profitability.

Progression: Agriculture Diploma Level 3.

Study Full-time

AGRICULTURE DIPLOMA LEVEL 3

Where: Bicton College and Duchy College Stoke Climsland
Entry Requirements: Four or more GCSEs at grade 4 or above, including English and/or maths, plus two sciences, or successful completion of a relevant Level 2 qualification.

Develop your technical knowledge and practical skills in order to gain a better understanding of the management of different agricultural enterprises and gain university entry. You will be learning from experienced agriculturalists both inside the classroom and on the College farm.

Progression: University study such as our FdSc Agriculture or employment in the industry.

Apprenticeship

GENERAL FARM WORKER LEVEL 2

Where: Bicton College, Duchy College Rosewarne and Duchy College Stoke Climsland
Entry Requirements: Three or more GCSEs at grade 3 including English and maths, as well as an employer willing to hire you as an apprentice.

As a general farm worker you could specialise in livestock or crop, and will assist with animal and plant health and nutrition, maintaining health and safety and biosecurity, and operating farm vehicles. Office work is minimal although basic daily record keeping will be required. You will be expected to undertake and pass a range of courses as part of this apprenticeship, including emergency first aid and the safe use and handling of pesticides.
Progression: On to a Level 3 Apprenticeship or a full-time study programme.

Apprenticeship

LIVESTOCK UNIT TECHNICIAN LEVEL 3

Where: Bicton College, Duchy College Rosewarne and Duchy College Stoke Climsland
Entry Requirements: Four or more GCSEs at grade 4 or above, including English and/or maths, or successful completion of a relevant Level 2 qualification.

A livestock unit technician is responsible for managing the livestock related tasks on a farm such as animal health and welfare from conception and birth through to the customer; and to support business productivity. The apprenticeship will develop your skills and knowledge enabling you to make key decisions to ensure the standards of health and safety, cross compliance, farm assurance, biosecurity and infrastructure security are met. You will usually only work with one species. The role will include the safe use and maintenance of farm vehicles, including the equipment used for transporting or producing feed. You will be required to understand, record and meet the business Key Performance Indicators that are set out by your employer.

You will be expected to undertake and pass a range of courses as part of this apprenticeship to include emergency first aid at work, safe use of veterinary medicines and the safe use of pesticides or safe application of pesticides using pedestrian hand held equipment.

Progression: University study such as our FdSc Agriculture or continue in employment in the industry.

CAREERS IN THIS INDUSTRY: FARM WORKER, FARM MANAGER, AGRICULTURAL SCIENTIST, AGRICULTURAL CONSULTANT.

Apprenticeship

CROP TECHNICIAN LEVEL 3

Where: Duchy College Rosewarne
Entry Requirements: Four or more GCSEs at grade 4 or above, including English and/or maths, or successful completion of a relevant Level 2 qualification.

As a crop technician you will be responsible for optimising crop/plant yields through establishment, management, harvest and post-harvest operations, while maintaining and improving the surrounding environment. You will also need to keep up-to-date with technological advances and new innovations. Being a crop technician requires self-motivation and the ability to work both independently and as a team player to complete tasks safely and efficiently. Many companies now use automation for a number of routine tasks, which will require technical skills to operate. This apprenticeship will develop your knowledge, skills and behaviours in core subjects before specialising in either soil based system or containerised systems.

You will be expected to undertake and pass a range of courses as part of this apprenticeship to include emergency first aid at work and the safe use of pesticides as well as choosing to do one of the following: boom sprayer, mounted, trailed or self-propelled equipment, granular applicator equipment or handheld applicator equipment.

Progression: University study such as our BSc Agriculture or continue in employment in the industry.

I want a career in... COUNTRYSIDE & CONSERVATION

The current climate emergency is changing the way we view and manage our planet and natural environment. In the future all businesses and organisations will be required to review and improve their impact on the environment. These courses will provide you with the skills and knowledge of how sustainability, conservation and the natural environment can be applied to a wide range of sectors.

Study Full-time

LAND-BASED STUDIES (COUNTRYSIDE CONSERVATION & HORTICULTURE) DIPLOMA LEVEL 1

Where: Bicton College and Duchy College Rosewarne
Entry Requirements: Two or more GCSEs at grade 2 or above, or successful completion of Entry Level qualification.

You will study a range of modules including plant and tree identification, estate skills, land-based machinery, tool use and care, wildlife and conservation and health and safety. The course acts as an introduction to countryside management and horticulture for students who love the outdoor learning environment, who are practically orientated and don't mind working in all weathers.

Progression: Land & Wildlife Diploma Level 2.

LAND & WILDLIFE DIPLOMA LEVEL 2

Where: Bicton College and Duchy College Rosewarne
Entry Requirements: Three or more GCSEs at grade 3 or above, or successful completion of a relevant Level 1 qualification.

During the course you will study a range of modules including estate skills, land-based machinery, species identification, ecology and wildlife conservation, health and safety, conservation of flora and fauna, and work experience. You will also learn the skills and knowledge to create boardwalks, post and rail fences, stiles, gates, hedge laying, surveying, management of invasive species, stream maintenance and tree planting.

Progression: Land & Wildlife Diploma Level 3.

CAREERS IN THIS INDUSTRY: RANGER, ECOLOGIST, ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH PRACTITIONER, NATURE CONSERVATION OFFICER.

Study Full-time

LAND & WILDLIFE DIPLOMA LEVEL 3

Where: Bicton College and Duchy College Rosewarne
Entry Requirements: Four or more GCSEs at grade 4 or above, including English and/or maths, or successful completion of a relevant Level 2 qualification.

This will give you the opportunity to undertake a vast array of surveys for flora and fauna; build stiles and boardwalks; erect post and rail and post and wire fencing; undertake scientific study of freshwater systems; monitor and map coastal processes; understand legislation involved with habitat restoration and conservation; species reintroduction and rewilding; and species identification along with your own specialist project.

Progression: University study such as our FdSc Countryside & Conservation at our Bicton campus or employment in the industry.

CONSERVATION AND ENVIRONMENTAL SUSTAINABILITY LEVEL 3

Where: Duchy College Rosewarne
Entry Requirements: Four or more GCSEs, including English, maths and science at grade 3.

With Cornwall as your classroom, get the specialist technical, practical and industry-relevant skills needed for a career in the rapidly growing environmental sector. Covering a wide range of topics, this course emphasizes reducing climate change, global warming, high carbon economy and the need for conservation.

Progression: Full-time employment or onto university study.

I want a career in... GAMEKEEPING

Creating and maintaining good, healthy habitats which are beneficial to all wildlife is at the heart of a gamekeeper's job. Gamekeeping has changed significantly over the years and while you will still be responsible for the husbandry of both reared and wild game for shooting, your time will also be spent helping to shape the countryside and protecting its species.

Study Full-time

GAMEKEEPING & CONSERVATION DIPLOMA LEVEL 3

Where: Duchy College Stoke Climsland
Entry Requirements: Four or more GCSEs at grade 4 or above, including English and/or maths, or successful completion of a relevant Level 2 qualification.

During this two-year course you will have access to Duchy College's 283-hectare estate and woodlands where you will care for the College's pheasants and learn about the management of game bird, deer, farm habitat, woodlands and fisheries. You will also study land-based machinery, working dogs, pest and predator control and will organise a number of shoot days from start to finish which will include costings, promotion, event preparation and running the activities on the day.

If you love working outdoors, care about the countryside and the environment and would like to make significant contributions to the biodiversity and conservation of rare species, then why not join the 5,000 full-time gamekeepers currently employed in the UK.

British gamekeepers currently manage approximately 7.3 million hectares of the land in the UK and work closely with farm managers and foresters to help conserve both game and wildlife, using economically viable estate management policies.

Progression: University study, a higher apprenticeship or employment in the gamekeeping or related industries.

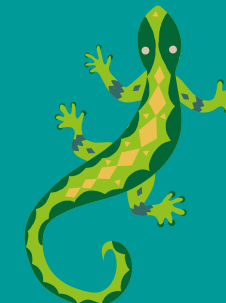

Study Full-time

ANIMAL CARE DIPLOMA LEVEL 1

Where: Bicton College, Duchy College Rosewarne and Duchy College Stoke Climsland

Entry requirements: Four GCSEs, with English or maths at grade 3, and the rest at grade 2.

Learn the basic skills to start your career working with animals. You will study how to care for small mammals, birds and farm animals, handle and feed animals, clean their accommodation and carry out basic health care.

Progression: Animal Care Certificate Level 2.

ANIMAL CARE CERTIFICATE LEVEL 2

Where: Bicton College, Duchy College Rosewarne and Duchy College Stoke Climsland

Entry requirements: Five GCSEs, including maths or English at grade 4, with the rest at grade 3 or above.

This one-year course will provide you with the basic knowledge and experience of working with and caring for a range of animals, including looking at their health and husbandry, control and restraint of animals and feeding requirements. You will also study optional units.

Progression: Animal Management Diploma Level 3.

CAREERS IN THIS INDUSTRY: ZOOKEEPER, ANIMAL CARE ASSISTANT, ZOOLOGIST

Study Full-time

ANIMAL MANAGEMENT DIPLOMA LEVEL 3

Where: Bicton College, Duchy College Rosewarne, Duchy College Stoke Climsland and Cornwall College Newquay

Entry requirements: Five GCSEs at grade 4 or above including English and maths.

This two-year course covers a wide range of topics including: animal behaviour and communication, biology, feeding and nutrition, health and husbandry, welfare, and breed development.

Progression: University study on one of our wide range of animal science, conservation and zoology degrees at Cornwall College Newquay, Duchy College and Bicton College.

Apprenticeship

ANIMAL CARE & WELFARE ASSISTANT APPRENTICESHIP LEVEL 2

Where: Bicton College, Duchy College Rosewarne and Duchy College Stoke Climsland

Entry requirements: Three or more GCSEs at grade 3 or above, or successful completion of a relevant Level 1 qualification. You will also need an employer willing to take you on as an apprentice.

Learn how to promote and maintain health and well-being; animal handling and grooming, and delivering basic treatment.

Progression: Animal Management Diploma Level 3 or employment in the industry.

I want a career in... VETERINARY NURSING

As a veterinary nurse you will provide support to sick and injured animals who are receiving treatment in a veterinary practice and provide expert nursing care. You will help to educate owners on maintaining the health of their pets and carry out a range of medical treatments under veterinary supervision. Knowing that you have helped nurse animals back to full health is one of the most rewarding careers.

Study Full-time

ANIMAL NURSING ASSISTANTS CERTIFICATE LEVEL 2

Where: Bicton College and Duchy College Rosewarne

Entry requirements: GCSE English or maths at grade 5 or above, and a further three GCSEs at grade 3 or above. If you are aged 16-18 you should also have a voluntary placement in a veterinary practice for two days a week. If you are 19+ you will need a one or two day paid or voluntary placement.

During this course you will learn the practical skills and the underpinning knowledge for all aspects of work in an assisting role within a veterinary practice including animal handling and care, assisting with care and administrative duties in the veterinary environment. You will also undertake at least one day a week work experience in a veterinary practice. This is a one year course, with one day a week in college. Maths or English GCSE can be studied on a second day where a grade 4 or above has not been obtained.

Progression: Veterinary Nursing Diploma Level 3 or our Animal Management Diploma Level 3.

CAREERS IN THIS INDUSTRY: VETERINARY NURSE, PET NUTRITIONIST, PET BEHAVIOURIST, VETERINARY PHYSIOTHERAPIST.

Apprenticeship

VETERINARY NURSING APPRENTICESHIP LEVEL 3

Where: Bicton College and Duchy College Rosewarne

Entry requirements: Five GCSEs including maths, English and a science at grade 5 or above.

During this two-and-a-half year course you will learn the operational requirements of a veterinary practice, veterinary nursing duties, anatomy, physiology and genetics, animal health, wellbeing and husbandry, supporting the supply of veterinary medicines, supporting veterinary anaesthesia and preoperative and post-operative nursing care.

You will spend one day a week on campus and the remaining four days in the workplace with your employer. There will also be occasional block weeks throughout the course. To study this course you must be in paid employment with a Royal College of Veterinary Surgeons approved training practice.

Our veterinary nursing teaching areas are designed to simulate a veterinary practice. We have a radiography room, laboratory, kennel area and operating theatre. We have many pieces of equipment that you would expect to find in a veterinary practice such as microscopes, anaesthetic machines, operating tables and a large variety of surgical instruments. With our equipment, purpose built facilities, working farms and equestrian centres, you will have access to animals you would expect to come across in veterinary practices.

Progression: Professional registration as a veterinary nurse or our FdSc Veterinary Nursing at our Rosewarne campus.



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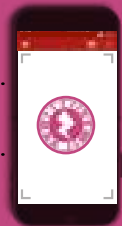

Zoos are no longer simply collections of animals for people to visit, they play a vital role in carrying out conservation work. Captive breeding programmes, protecting endangered species, and inspiring the next generation to care and protect these animals, are all essential tasks zoos carry out on a day-to-day basis and you could play a vital role in this important work.

Study Full-time

Study Full-time

ANIMAL MANAGEMENT DIPLOMA LEVEL 3

Where: Duchy College Rosewarne, Duchy College Stoke Climsland and Cornwall College Newquay

Entry requirements: 5 or more GCSEs at grade 4 or above, including English, maths and science.

This course is perfect if you would like a career caring for animals in a zoo-based setting. We work in partnership with Dartmoor Zoological Park and Newquay Zoo to ensure you gain the practical, real-life experience that employers look for. During this course you will study a wide range of subjects including animal nutrition, animal handling and safe working, health and welfare, husbandry of exotic species, animal biology, animal training, behaviour, breeding, zoological collections and wildlife ecology.

There are one- and two-year options available with this pathway and we will work with you to decide which is best for you. Our state of the art animal management centre at Duchy College Rosewarne provides dedicated practical facilities for working with a range of animals, including exotic species, aquatics, birds,

zoo animals and large animals, with links highly qualified and industry experienced teaching staff. At Duchy College Stoke Climsland there are strong links with Dartmoor Zoological Park and two days per week are spent there, with a further day on campus and a day of work experience at Dartmoor Zoo working alongside the zoo staff.

Our Newquay campus is situated next door to Newquay Zoo, where we have a dedicated classroom. We also have very close links with Blue Reef Aquarium where you will be able to develop your knowledge of aquatic animals. You will share your first year with the Animal Management Diploma and this is the qualification you will receive on completion of your course.

Progression: University study such as Cornwall College Newquay's FdSc Zoology with Ecology and Conservation and FdSc Animal Behaviour and Welfare with possible further progression on to BSc (Hons) Applied Zoology & Conservation or BSc (Hons) Applied Marine Zoology.

“The work experience side of my course really helped me find exactly what career I wanted.”



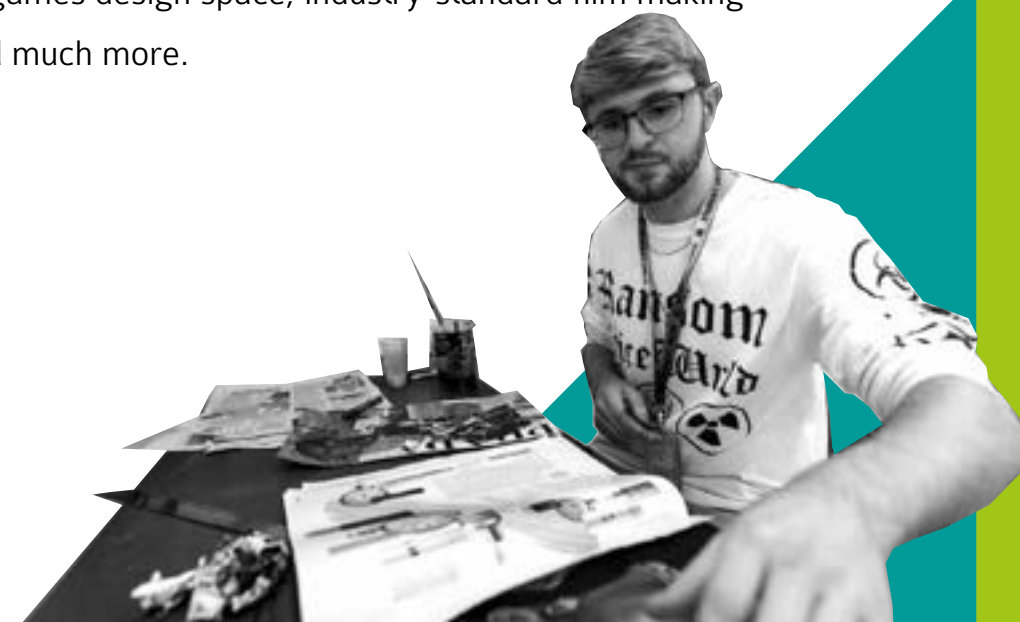

Study Full-time

ART & DESIGN DIPLOMA LEVEL 2

Where: Camborne and St Austell

Entry Requirements: Three or more GCSEs at grade 3 or above, or successful completion of a relevant Level 1 qualification.

This one-year course allows you to experiment with drawing, painting, collage and mixed media, 3D, textiles, graphic design, Photoshop editing, and photography. You will be encouraged to try everything with an open mind, so that we can then help you find your talent and support you in developing your specialism. Projects are varied and are designed for you to be able to personalise them so that you can develop an individual style.

Progression: Art & Design Practice Diploma Level 3.

ART & DESIGN DIPLOMA LEVEL 3

Entry Requirements: Four or more GCSEs at grade 4 or above, including English and/or maths, or successful completion of a relevant Level 2 qualification.

During this two-year course you will learn new skills and techniques and you will also learn about yourself as a creative. What are you passionate about? What do you want your art to communicate? How can you fit your creative skills into a job that you love? You will leave with the skills needed to become part of the fastest growing area of the UK economy.

Do you love games? Are you passionate about platformers, barmy for board games and know your RPG stats inside out? Then why not come and join us on the games design course and find out what you are capable of!

Study Full-time

GAMES DESIGN & ANIMATION DIPLOMA LEVEL 3

Where: Camborne and St Austell

Entry Requirements: Four or more GCSEs at grade 4 or above, including English and/or maths, or successful completion of a relevant Level 2 qualification.

This two-year course is practically focused and coursework based and you will learn the skills needed to move onto university or your first steps into the ever expanding UK games industry. We focus on the development of games and game art and assets, so you don't need to be a coding master to succeed.

In the first year of the course you will look at the analysis and design of games, create 2D and 3D levels, undertake market research of your own game ideas and prepare those ideas for development, learn employability skills and manage teams to create products, investigate web design and analyse and create sound effects for games. You will even create a fully realised board game, use 3D printing techniques and a full production process to launch the product in a live premiere event – and all in just ten days.

In year two you will create social action games, research and produce academic essays, apply for university and get your career

goals set up alongside making your own 3D animated characters. Both years will see you create your own final projects for end of year assessment.

Making use of the most up-to-date games development and digital media software you will learn to create with Adobe Creative Suite, including Premiere Pro, Photoshop, Animate, After effects and more. 3D modelling software such as Autodesk 3Ds Max and Autodesk Maya. Game engines like Construct 3 and Ue4 and learn to work with the latest gadgets like the Oculus Rift Virtual Reality System.

For those students who don't quite meet the entry requirements we also run a one-year Media & Animation Diploma Level 2 designed to feed directly into the games course the following year.

Progression: University study such as our Games Design for Industry HND with possible progression on to our BA (Hons) Games Design for Industry (top-up). Or employment in the industry.

Where: Camborne and St Austell

Entry Requirements: Three or more GCSEs at grade 3 or above, or successful completion of a relevant Level 1 qualification.

This one-year course introduces you to media skills and processes used in the industry today. You'll learn about manual camera operation and composition, professional sound recording, creative software use, professional pre-production, structuring video content, editing techniques etc. By developing these skills at Level 2, you will be well prepared to enter into more specialised study in further qualifications. The diploma is coursework based, meaning there are no exams as part of the media course. It's all about giving you the practical skills and experience behind the camera, in a project management role to lead a production.

Progression: Creative Media Production Diploma Level 3, Games Design & Animation Diploma Level 3 or Photography-Creative-Commercial Diploma Level 3. Alternatively you could go into employment.

This two-year course gives you the required media skills and experience to work in the industry. You'll learn about manual camera operation and composition, professional sound recording, script-writing, journalism, film production, editing techniques, creative software and lots more including our two week intensive nationally recognised film making machine, Film School.

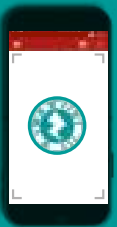

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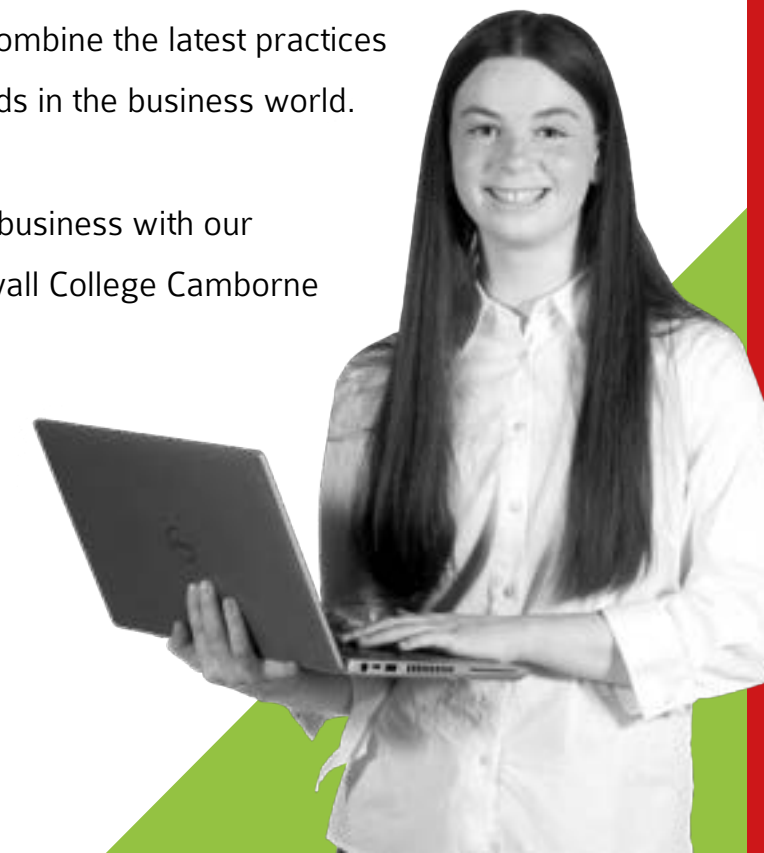

**CUSTOMER SERVICE PRACTITIONER
APPRENTICESHIP LEVEL 2**

Where: St Austell
Entry Requirements: Three or more GCSEs at grade 3 or above, or successful completion of a relevant Level 1 qualification. Plus an employer willing to take you on as an apprentice.

This apprenticeship gives you the chance to choose and tailor your training to the job role of your dreams, leading to potential careers in business, marketing, sales, customer service or HR. With a focus on developing essential customer service skills at its core you will spend time at college learning skills and theory to help you in the workplace.
Progression: Business Administration Apprenticeship Level 3.

An assistant accountant provides support to internal and external customers and will work predominately either as an assistant accountant or within finance at an organisation. In addition, the assistant accountant may find themselves involved in regulatory financial requirements such as the completion of VAT returns or assisting in the preparation of tax computations.
Progression: You can progress onto the AAT Professional Accounting Technician Apprenticeship Level 4.

TEAM LEADER/SUPERVISOR LEVEL 3

Where: St Austell
Entry Requirements: Four or more GCSEs at grade 4 or above including English and/or maths, or successful completion of a relevant Level 2 qualification. Plus an employer willing to take you on as an apprentice, employed at a supervisory management level.

This apprenticeship will cover being a leader; personal development as a first line manager, resource planning, managing and communicating information, identifying development opportunities, management communication, meeting stakeholder needs, plus complete an end point assessment.

On successful completion you will become a certified practitioner, of the Chartered Institute of Housing.

This is a practical course that will equip you with the skills and knowledge to work across a variety of sectors in the catering and food service industries, from event catering to fine dining restaurants. This apprenticeship is for learners working in a wide range of hospitality settings across the service and commercial sectors. A chef de partie is responsible for running a specific section of the kitchen. This type of chef usually manages a small team of workers, which they must keep organised so that dishes go out on time and the work area remains clean and orderly, for example, sauces, pastries or fish. However, in smaller kitchens a chef de partie may work independently as the only person in their section. Also known as a station or section chef, the chef de partie reports to the senior chef and has a very important role in any kitchen. During this apprenticeship the emphasis is on culinary skills, team management, health and safety and all business aspects of the hospitality industry. You will also develop a deeper understanding of preparing and cooking a range of commodities including: fish, shellfish, meat, poultry, game, offal, vegetables, stock, sauces, soup, bread and dough, pastry, cakes, and hot and cold desserts with the ability to transfer this knowledge to junior members of the team.

Progression: Employment in the industry.

WORKING WITH CHILDREN IN EARLY YEARS & PRIMARY SETTINGS CERTIFICATE LEVEL 2

Where: Camborne and St Austell

Entry Requirements: Four GCSEs at grade 3 or above including maths and English, DBS evidence in place prior to enrolment, and work placement secured within six weeks of enrolment.

This one-year course allows you to get hands on in a childcare setting and primary school, interacting with children and being part of a team whose main aim is to provide a caring and enabling environment.

You will take part in a weekly work placement and attend college in order to complete the course.

You will take part in practical and theory lessons, in well-equipped classrooms that replicate the childcare and primary school settings. Explore the world of all ages of children, from learning about nappy changing, to preparing bottles, making nutritious food, to setting up an exciting and educational play environment, and getting creative with arts and crafts and sensory play.

During this two-year course you will learn why children behave the way they do and the theory that supports their development and learning. You will also develop skills to carry out child observations using children who come into college or are in the workplace.

An important aspect of being an early years practitioner is learning your roles and responsibilities when with children, so we look at legislation, keeping children safe and working in partnership with others. You will be taught by sector experienced tutors who are there to fully support you in your chosen career.

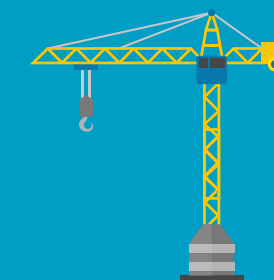
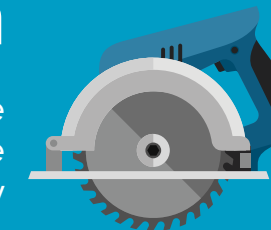

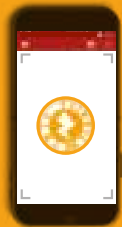

Become an essential part of the construction industry. Bricklayers are responsible for setting out buildings using blocks, bricks and mortar in accordance with approved construction plans. Bricklayers also build and repair walls, chimney stacks, tunnel linings and decorative work such as archways. They might also refurbish brickwork and masonry on restoration projects.

Study Full-time

HORSE CARE LEVEL 1

Where: Bicton College and Duchy College Stoke Climsland
Entry requirements: Four GCSEs, with English or maths at grade 3, and the rest at grade 2.

This one-year course introduces you to the equine industry and develops your essential skills. You'll be learning from experienced and well qualified staff, who are there to give you the very best start to your career. There are two options on the course, riding or non-riding. You'll be working on a range of different topics and units including: mucking out, rugs and rugging, tack and tacking up, feeding and watering, health and safety, communication, handling horses and riding horses.

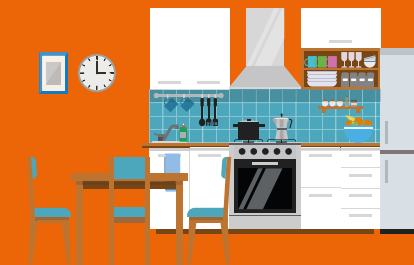

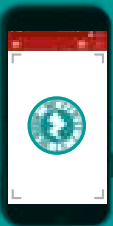

I want to become more... INDEPENDENT, CONFIDENT AND RESILIENT

Within the supported learning team our vision is to support you to be INDEPENDENT, CONFIDENT AND RESILIENT so that you are well-prepared to engage with the wider community.

Independence Pathway

Preparing for adulthood with a focus on independence; confidence; resilience; physical and sensory development, and skills to enhance quality of life.

INDEPENDENCE STAGE 1

Where: Camborne
Entry Requirements: No formal qualifications are required for Foundation Level courses.

This course helps to develop your independence. This is achieved through knowledge and skills that will support your transition to adulthood, with a clear focus on developing your personal progress in this area. On this pathway you will work towards individual personal targets linked to different areas of independence, which may include: Learning to travel by bus or train; independent living at home, e.g. basic home cooking skills or keeping the home clean and tidy; independent living in the community, which may include learning to go shopping or going to a restaurant; personal development, such as learning to keep safe and the importance of staying healthy. We will work with you, your parents and carers in designing your programme of study, setting your targets and assessing progress inside and outside of college.

Progression: Once you have completed this pathway you may wish to progress on to other pathways within Foundation Learning such as Skills or Works. If you leave college, you will leave with skills that will enable you to be more independent at home or in the community.

Independence Pathway

INDEPENDENCE STAGE 2

Where: Camborne and St Austell
Entry Requirements: No formal qualifications are required for Foundation Level courses.

Within this pathway you will focus on developing your independence and you could also develop your vocational skills. We will support you in developing your skills in using English and maths too. Aside from the academic skills, we will work with you to develop a range of social and interaction skills to help prepare you for your next steps. You will get the opportunity to try skills independently.

You will select from a range of different vocational subjects. This will enable you to assess your transferable skills and help prepare you for your future. English and maths will also be delivered within your course through a City & Guilds Functional Skills qualification at a level appropriate to you.

Progression: Once you have completed this pathway you may wish to progress on to other pathways within Foundation Learning such as Skills or Works. If you leave college, you will leave with skills that will enable you to be more independent at home or in the community.



Skills Pathway

To explore destinations and work towards next steps. Further develop independence; behaviour and communication skills; English and maths. Includes tasters for a range of vocational areas if further education is your goal.

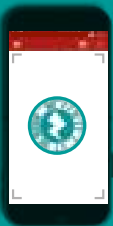
Where: Bicton College, Camborne, Duchy College Stoke Climsland and St Austell
Entry Requirements: Working at Entry Level 2 or above in English and maths.

On this course you will develop skills, knowledge and behaviours for successful learning. You will also gain an insight into different vocational options that will support successful career planning and progression to further study or work. The vocational options on offer are specific to the campus you choose to study at, and use specialists to deliver where required. Learners tell us that the opportunity to explore cross-college vocational pathways is an opportunity to understand what the higher-level course would be like. They also get to know the staff, gain skills and build confidence to apply for a higher-level course in their chosen subject area.

Progression: Once you have completed this pathway, you may wish to progress on to other pathways within Foundation Learning such as Vocational or Works. You may feel ready for a higher-level course.

Within the Vocational Academy team our vision is to support you to be CONFIDENT, RESILIENT AND WORK READY so that you are well-prepared to engage with the wider community.

Vocational Pathway

Take part in a range of vocational options to help you make an informed choice for your future vocational area, and develop vocational knowledge and study skills for a successful transition.

VOCATIONAL STAGE 1

Where: Bicton College, Camborne, Duchy College Stoke Climsland and St Austell

Entry Requirements: Working at Entry Level 3 or above in English and maths.

This course is ideal if you are unsure of the subject you wish to pursue as a career. You will experience a range of vocational options to help you make that choice. The options on offer are specific to the campus you choose to study at. During the course you will study vocational and life skills around the areas of work that you have chosen to study. You will also build your teamwork skills, self-confidence and develop your English and maths.

Progression: Pathway 2 Employment (P2E) Stage 1.

Vocational Pathway

VOCATIONAL STAGE 2

Where: Camborne

Entry Requirements: Entry 3 – Level 1 learners offered qualifications relevant to current academic ability.

You will study vocational and life skills around your chosen to study areas. You will also build your teamwork skills, self-confidence and develop your English and maths. Vocational areas range from media to horticulture, motor vehicles to hairdressing, sport to creative arts, catering to health and social care, plus more. You will also explore employability skills and have the opportunity to access work placement hours.

Entry Requirements: No formal qualifications are required for Foundation Level courses.

You will learn the skills, knowledge and behaviours to prepare you for the world of work. You will get the opportunity to visit local employers and also follow a career plan to match your skills and interests with different jobs and careers and work with the P2E co-ordinator to find the right work placement for your supported internship at stage 2, if you chose this progression pathway.

Progression: During this year you will prepare for Pathway to Employment Stage 2 and explore possible work placements for your Supported Internship with our P2E Co-Ordinator and our employer links. You may also progress straight into employment.

PATHWAY 2 EMPLOYMENT STAGE 2 (SUPPORTED INTERNSHIP) LEVEL 1

Where: Bicton College, Duchy College Stoke Climsland and St Austell

Entry Requirements: Two or more GCSEs at grade 2 or above, or successful completion of Entry Level qualification.

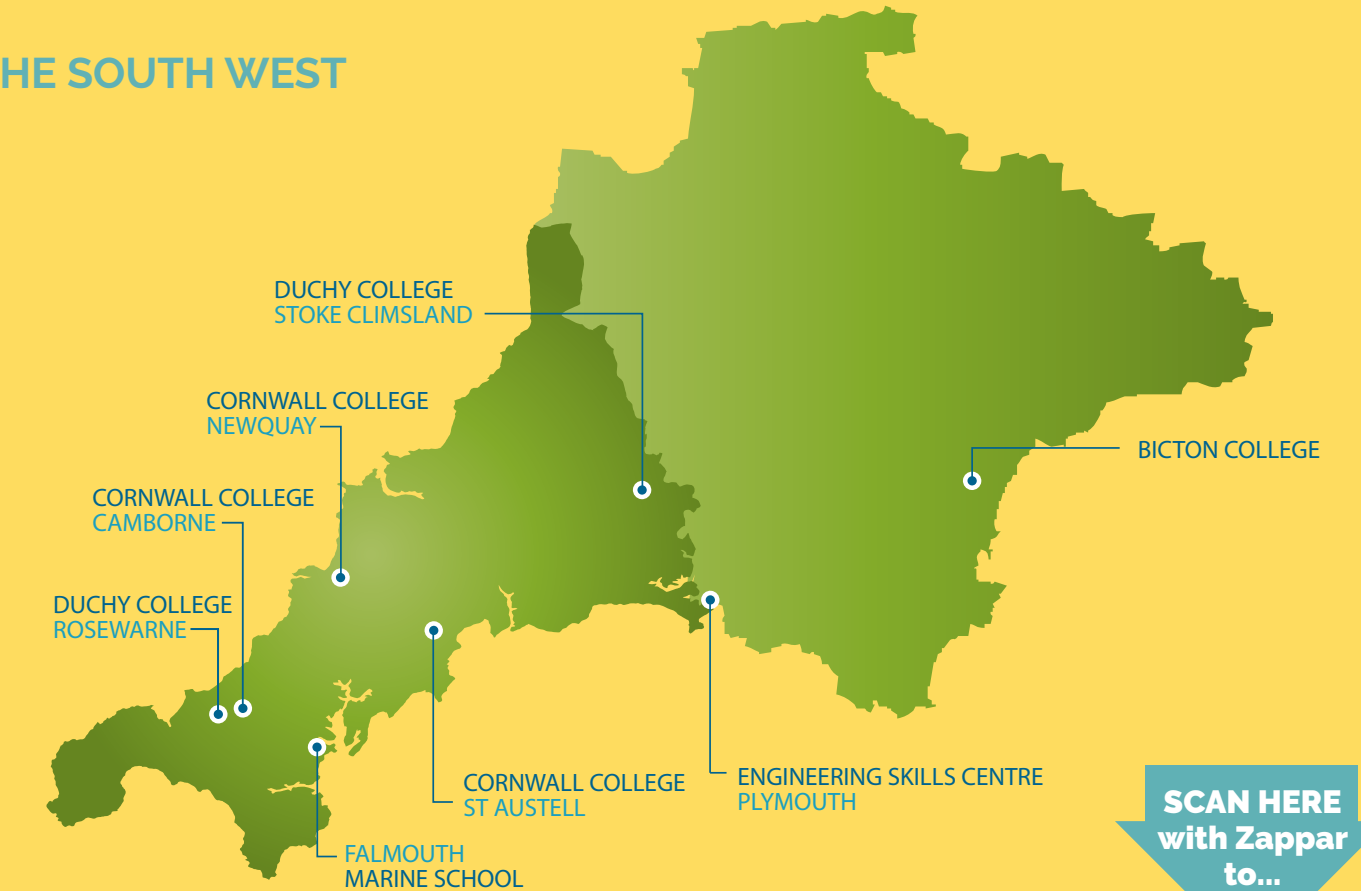
